USCG Air Station Los Angeles. Fair Winds and Following Seas. The disappointing news this year was the closing of the Coast Guard Air Station at LAX. President Emeritus Ron Dutton attended the official decommissioning ceremony held May 20th at the USCG Air Station HQ, LAX. Several distinguished guests were on hand to wish the command a fond farewell including Rear Adm. Joseph A. Servidio, 11th Coast Guard District commander, Cmdr. Thomas Cooper, commanding officer, Coast Guard Air Station Los Angeles, Cmdr. Ben Maule, executive officer, Coast Guard Air Station Los Angeles, the command and crew of Coast Guard Air Station Los Angeles as well as active duty, reserve, retired, and auxiliary members from all over the United States. Due to airport expansion, the Coast Guard shifted helicopter operations in the area to a Forward Operating Base (FOB) at Naval Base Ventura County Wednesday, May 18, 2016. Helicopters operating from the FOB will continue to support Coast Guard missions such as search and rescue, law enforcement and port security along the California coast from Dana Point to Morro Bay until a permanent station is built.


